As we approach the end of the half term, I thought I would update you on what is happening in school and inform you of some of the upcoming events happening after the holidays.


#### **Building Work**

Following the new roof that was installed in the kitchen and the front of school, the rest of the building is now due some attention. Among other things, the local authority are going to repair the external roof and replace some of the aging internal ceilings and lighting. This work is due to begin at Easter but some preparation work is already underway. The plan is to complete work on the hall during the school holidays, if possible, to avoid disruption to school dinners, PE lessons, etc. The planned work on the classrooms, however, will cause some disruption, as each class will have to vacate their room until the work has been completed. We will ensure that this disruption is minimal and the children's planned curriculum and learning will not change. Each class will move into a temporary classroom while the building work is completed, and they will take all their equipment and resources with them. The work is scheduled to be completed by the end of the year, by which point we will have new ceilings, roofs, internal lighting, alarm system and network cabling throughout the school.

## **World Book Day**

We will be celebrating World Book Day on Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup> March. You may send your child to school dressed as a book character if you wish. There will be no charge for this.

In school, we are planning lots of fun activities for children to take part in and we will be celebrating some fantastic authors during the course of the day. This year, one of our main priorities is developing reading so we will make the most of this opportunity to celebrate books!



#### **Mystery Reader**

#### **Midday Supervisor Vacancy**
